After analyzing the reason for the seemingly slow reservation pace, the board concluded that because of the Labor Day holiday, the invitations should probably have been sent out a bit earlier. In the future, invitations will be mailed 20 days in advance of the dance. This should leave enough time for members to receive them and submit their reservation and payment.

- If you have to cancel a reservation, try to cancel it 7 days in advance. This way the club can refund your money. However, if you cannot attend because of last minute problems, we will always try to refund your money if we can. If we have to pay for your dinners then of course, a refund will not be forthcoming.
- Doors open at 6:30 P.M. Try not to arrive before this time since venue staff is often still setting up and arranging tables, etc. In addition, our own Hospitality people are also busy placing name tags for guests and sponsors, setting up centerpieces, and getting things ready at the hostess table. If you are there too early, we will be forced to put you to work.
