On May 16, we return to the attractive Anaheim Sheraton (by Disneyland) for our spring formal dance with the super popular Street Corner Symphony band, our favorite—"the best band in the land." Many will recall the Starlighter Summer Casual dance at the Sheraton last July. It was a wonderful affair with all expectations met and exceeded. The Sheraton provides a very generous size dance floor, second only to the Phoenix Club, which will allow you to do your fanciest steps. Hors d'oeuvres are five-star, and the Sheraton chefs serve a very high quality dinner. The menu planned includes a scrumptious Caesar Salad, with entrée choice of Pacific Halibut with a tangy lemon caper sauce or individual Beef Wellington served with a mushroom duxelle, Twice Baked Potatoes and Green Beans Almondine round out the entree, For dessert a wonderful, not-to-be-missed, mouth-watering cheesecake with strawberry sauce will fortify your best efforts on the dance floor. You may bring your own wine selection for a mere \$10 corkage fee. The cost will be \$125 per couple. Doors open at 6:30 PM. Don't be too early. Don't be late!!

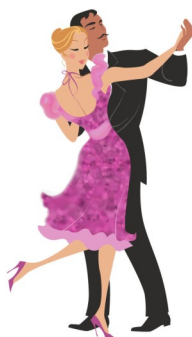
