Starlighters Return to the Foxfire for 2011 Winter Holiday Formal



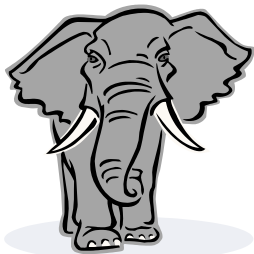

The 2012 Starlighter Board will be voted into office at November formal dance

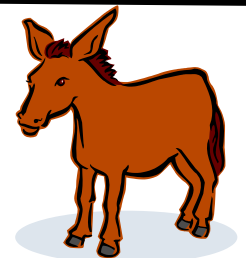
